RECORDS!

- The Cuerdale Hoard: One of the largest Viking silver hoards, found in England in 1840, containing over 8,600 items including coins and jewelry from the 9th century.
- The Nuestra Señora de Atocha: A Spanish galleon sunk in 1622 off Florida, discovered in 1985 with a treasure worth around \$400 million, including gold, silver, and gems.
- 3. The Staffordshire Hoard: The largest hoard of Anglo-Saxon gold and silver artifacts, discovered in England in 2009, consisting of over 3,500 items valued at about \$4.1 million.

The "Welcome Stranger" gold nugget, unearthed in 1869 in Victoria, Australia, was the largest ever found. Its estimated worth today, based on a \$1,800 per troy ounce gold price, is around \$4.1 million, making it a legendary symbol of hidden treasures.
