IDEAS OF WHERE YOU MIGHT LIKE TO DONATE YOUR GOODS

Donation Destination	Suggested Items for Donation
Local Homeless Shelters	Warm clothing (coats, sweaters, socks), blankets, toiletries (soap, toothpaste, shampoo)
Refugee Centers	Clothing (especially winter coats), shoes, school supplies (notebooks, pencils, backpacks)
Orphanages and Children's Homes	Toys (stuffed animals, action figures), books (storybooks, coloring books), clothing
Low-Income Schools	School supplies (notebooks, pens, pencils), backpacks, age-appropriate books
Nursing Homes	Puzzle books (crossword puzzles, Sudoku), lap blankets, toiletries (lotions, tissues)
Women's Shelters	Hygiene products (feminine hygiene items, shampoo, soap), clothing (women's and children's), diapers
Animal Shelters	Old blankets (for bedding), towels (for cleaning), pet food (dry and canned)
Local Hospitals (Children's Wards)	Stuffed animals, coloring books, crayons, children's books
Food Banks	Non-perishable food items (canned goods, pasta, rice, canned fruit, peanut butter)
Community Centers	Art supplies (crayons, markers, paper), board games (chess, Scrabble), sports equipment (balls)
Libraries	Books (children's books, young adult novels, educational books), educational materials (puzzles, flashcards)
Foster Care Organizations	Clothing (new or gently used), school supplies (backpacks, pencils, erasers), toys (age-appropriate)
Veterans' Assistance Programs	Toiletries (shaving cream, razors, deodorant), warm clothing (hats, gloves, scarves), books (war history, novels)
Community Art Centers	Art supplies (paints, brushes, canvases), craft materials (beads, glue, construction paper)
Homeless Outreach Programs	Sleeping bags, hygiene products (toothbrushes, soap), warm clothing (gloves, thermal socks)
Environmental Cleanup Organizations	Recycling bins, reusable bags, gardening tools (shovels, gloves)
Youth Clubs and Community Centers	Sports equipment (soccer balls, basketballs), board games (Monopoly, Uno), art supplies (coloring books, crayons)
Toy Drives for Disadvantaged Children	New toys (action figures, dolls, building blocks), puzzles, games (board games, card games)
Senior Centers	Puzzle books (crossword puzzles, jigsaw puzzles), board games (chess, checkers), lap blankets
